**What do I need to do next?**

If you would like your child to go on the trip, please complete and return the form below, together with an initial deposit of £30 by Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2019. Further payments will be required by Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2019 (£40) and the outstanding balance by Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2020 (£44). Please note that once deposits have been paid to PGL they are not refundable and terms and conditions will apply.

Also, closer to departure, we will ask for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the transport. This follows the guidelines set out in our school charging and remission policy which is available on our school website. Once we know the final number of children attending the trip we will be able to work out this contribution. Many thanks for your support.
